38. Most people knew something about the greenhouse effect. Factories send gases such as carbon dioxide, or CO₂ into the atmosphere. In the past, this wasn't a problem because trees absorbed, or drank in, CO₂. But now people don't pay much attention to the environment. At the same time, factories are sending more CO₂ into the atmosphere every year. One ton is 2000 pounds, so this is a lot of pollution. There is too much CO₂ and there aren't enough trees, so the world is getting warmer. In other words, we have a greenhouse effect. This is terrible for the environment.
